Continuing a Father's Day tradition, pictures will be taken of fathers with their children Sunday, June 19. The pictures are a reminder of the sacred bond between men and their children and the sacred responsibility God has given to fathers to guide their children to grow in their baptismal faith within the church community. Building a bond with your child will have long-lasting effects. Strengthen your father-child relationship by: **Doing things together**—Children benefit from your attention. Read to your child, play, tell stories of your childhood, share meals, celebrate accomplishments; Talking—Start talking to your children when they're young, and not just about serious issues or things they've done wrong; Listening—Listen to your child's stories/ideas, feelings, problems and experiences—and respond without always expressing an opinion; Teaching—Teach the difference between right and wrong as well as life skills. Give praise when your child learns something new; Disciplining with love—Remind your children, calmly and consistently, of the consequences of their actions. Reward them for good behavior; Showing affection—Hug your children and tell them that you will always love them, no matter what. Even after your children leave the nest, stay involved. Ask how they're doing—and then listen attentively.
